

What happened to the manufacturing industry in Barbados?

The manufacturing industry in Barbados was heavily affected by the economic recession of the 1990s. The sector employed about 10,000 Barbadians but was one of the worst-hit industries by the recession. There has been evidence of growth in the industry since then.

What is the current economic status of Barbados?

Since independence, the economy of Barbados has been transformed from a high-income economy dependent on sugar production to an upper-middle-income economy based on offshore and tourism sectors*. The economic growth rate has averaged between 3-5% since 1993, after a 3-year recession.*

What is GDP in Barbados?

The Gross Domestic Product (GDP) is the measurement of the total flow of output (goods & services) and the total flow of inputs (factors of production) that pass through all the markets of the economy during a specific period (usually one year). The annual and quarterly GDP for Barbados is generated by the expenditure and production approaches.

What are the main industries in Barbados?

Agriculture is one of the main industries in Barbados, employing approximately 27% of the workforce. About 16,000 hectares of land (37% of the total land area) is considered as arable land. The agricultural sector in Barbados is dominated by sugarcane production.

What is Barbados' agricultural sector focused on?

Barbados' agricultural sector is primarily focused on sugarcane production. At some point, almost all the arable land was covered by sugarcane plants. In 1999, the country produced 0.5 million tons of sugarcane, and in 2001, the produce generated US\$22 million in export earnings or 8.4% of the total exports.

What goods are produced in Barbados?

Barbados produces manufactured goods for the local market, such as tinned foods, cigarettes, and drinks. However, the export market has faced increased competition from cheaper Caribbean countries. Barbados has very limited mineral resources and relies mainly on imports to meet local demands.
