

Should wine be stored on the side?

Keeping your bottles on their sides, with wine constantly in contact with the cork, you won't run the risk of having a "corked" wine. DON'T: Store your wine upright for long term. For the same reason it's recommended to store wine on its side is why it is not recommended to store it upright.

I wouldn't recommend keeping bottles upright for more than a few weeks. DO: Keep your wine at a constant temperature.

Should wine bottles be stored horizontally or vertically?

How do you store wine in an apartment?

Wines stored in apartments for an extended period should be stored in a portable wine refrigerator. A countertop wine cooler is not very expensive and holds about 18 bottles of wine.
