Instead of placing loose tea bags inside a drawer, keep them neatly organized with the help of extendable drawer dividers. Dividers allow you to create multiple compartments, so you can sort tea bags by type and see what you're looking for as soon as you open the drawer.

There is a reason why most tea storage containers are not clear glass. That is because light can have an effect on the quality of the tea. Tea leaves are sensitive to light and compounds found in them can experience what is called photo-oxidative changes.
