Never carry it horizontally. The ideal place to safely store your refrigerator is in a storage unit. When storing an appliance long-term, it's critical to store it in a clean and dry environment. You want to take all the necessary measures to ensure your appliance remains in good condition despite being in storage for a long time.

Refrigerators should maintain temperatures between 2°C and 8°C (36°F and 46°F). Freezers should maintain temperatures between -50°C and -15°C (-58°F and +5°F).
