Construction has begun on a solar-plus-storage project on the Caribbean island of St. Kitts & Nevis, backed by Leclanché, Solrid and MPC Energy Solutions. The launch of the SOLEC power plant is nearly 18 months ...

Most power on both islands is generated by diesel generators (95%) with 3.9% of wind and only 1.77% of solar. There are high power losses of 20% on Nevis and 17% on St Kitts suggesting maintenance problems. St Kitts has installed capacity of 43 mW and Nevis 13.4 mW but government has plans for a further 70 mW.

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
