

Should you install solar panels before buying a home?

The age and condition of your roof also matter. If your roof needs repairs or replacement soon, it's best to address that before installing solar panels. Solar panels are an attractive feature to buyers and typically increase a home's value. That means you may be able to recoup some of your installation costs if you need to sell in the future.

Do solar panels work without direct sunlight?

Solar energy systems don't perform well without direct sunlight. Your roof isn't ideally oriented: In North America, south-facing roofs are best, although east- or west-facing roofs can be just fine, as long as they don't have too steep of a slope.

Can solar panels be installed on a roof?

Your installers will usually need to erect scaffolding to install solar panels on your roof. Once this is up, solar panels can be installed in a day or two. The inverter will usually be fitted in either a loft or garage. This converts the DC your panels produce to AC that you can use in your home.

Can solar panels be installed on the ground?

You can install solar panels on the ground, but are more expensive to install and require additional space. Consult a reputable solar panel installer to confirm whether your roof is compatible with solar panels. You'll see the best return on investment if you install solar panels on a home you plan to stay in for a while.
