The Government of B.C. is contributing as much as \$80 million to E-One Moli's new facility in Maple Ridge, which will anchor the company's North American production.

What is E-One Moli Energy's new high-performance lithium-ion battery facility?

Why did E-One Moli Energy get funding?

"We've provided E-One Moli Energy with funding to assist in transitioning some of their manufacturing processes from fossil fuels to clean electricity and help reduce the overall cost of connecting to our system.

When will E-One Moli Energy be fully operational?

Construction of the E-One Moli Energy manufacturing facility is expected to begin in June 2024 and be fully operational in 2028.

E-One Moli's existing facility has been operating in Maple Ridge since 1990, and it had been estimated that expanding the plant would create 350 new permanent jobs in addition to...
