Does Sao Tome and Principe have a right to education?

The Human Rights Measurement Initiative (HRMI) finds that Sao Tome and Principe is fulfilling only 83.8% of its expected commitments to the right to education based on the country's level of income. HRMI breaks down the right to education by looking at the rights to both primary education and secondary education.

Where is Sao Tom and Principe located?

The republic, which lies about 200 km off the west coast of Gabon, in the Gulf of Guinea, comprises the main islands of Sao Tom (845 sq. km) and Principe and several smaller islets including Pedras Tinhosas and Rolas. It has a total area of 1,001 sq. km (387 sq. miles). Population (census, 2012) 179,200; density, 228 per sq. km (2020).

When did the Portuguese leave Sao Tom and Principe?

The Portuguese left in 1975, but the islands still bear traces of colonial rule. Sao Tom and Principe City, the island's capital, has been described as a "miniature Havana", with its colourful colonial buildings, Portuguese-style churches and turquoise ocean views.

How many people live in Sao Tom and Principe?

The UN gave a projected population for 2025 of 240,979. Areas and populations of the two provinces: The capital, Sao Tom, had an estimated population of 67,000 in 2012. The official language is Portuguese. Lungwa, a Portuguese Creole, and Fang, a Bantu language, are the spoken languages. 2020: births, 4,000; deaths (2017), 1,202.
