El Salvador is the smallest and most densely populated country in Central America. It is well into its demographic transition,experiencing slower population growth,a decline in its number of youths,and the gradual aging of its population.

Is El Salvador a member of the World Trade Organization?

El Salvador is a member of the World Trade Organizationand is pursuing regional free trade agreements. An active participant in the Summit of the Americas process,El Salvador chairs a working group on market access under the Free Trade Area of the Americas initiative.

When did El Salvador become a country?

El Salvador declared its independence from the Federal Republic of Central America on 30 January 1841. El Salvador joined Honduras and Nicaragua in 1896 to form the Greater Republic of Central America,which dissolved in 1898. After the mid-19th century,the economy was based on coffee growing.

Does El Salvador have a Caribbean coast?

Its territory is situated wholly on the western side of the isthmus,and it is therefore the only Central American country that lacks a Caribbean coast. The entire territory of El Salvador is located on the Central American volcanic axis,which determines the major geographic regions of the country.

Is El Salvador a Christian country?

The majority of the population in El Salvador is Christian. Catholics (43.3%) and Protestants (33.9%) are the two major religious groups in the country,with the Catholic Church the largest denomination. Those not affiliated with any religious group amount to 18.6% of the population.
