

Is Equatorial Guinea part of OPEC?

Equatorial Guinea, a former Spanish colony, consists of the mainland, Rio Muni, and five islands including Bioko, where the capital Malabo is, and the Alba gas plant, is located. Equatorial Guinea is one of sub-Saharan's biggest oil and gas producers and is a member of OPEC.

Is Equatorial Guinea a kleptocratic country?

Equatorial Guinea was the 174th lowest scoring nation out of a total of 180 countries. Freedom House, a pro-democracy and human rights NGO, described Obiang as one of the world's "most kleptocratic living autocrats", and complained about the US government welcoming his administration and buying oil from it.

Is Equatorial Guinea a member of CFA?

It is a member of the Central African Economic and Monetary Union (CEMAC), which includes Cameroon, Central African Republic, Chad, Congo/Brazzaville, and Gabon. Equatorial Guinea is also part of the central Africa CFA franc zone, and the Cameroon-based Bank of Central African States coordinates monetary policy.

Is Equatorial Guinea a corrupt country?

In October 2004, the military staged an abortive coup leading to the conviction of 23 soldiers. Equatorial Guinea ranked 152 out of 159 countries on Transparency International's Corruption Perceptions Index 2005 with almost none of the economic benefits from the oil windfall trickling down to the average Equatorial Guinean.

How many military members does Equatorial Guinea have?

The military of Equatorial Guinea was reorganized in 1979. It consists of approximately 2,500 service members. The army has 1,400 soldiers, the police 400 paramilitary men, the navy 200 service members, and the air force about 120 members. There is a Gendarmerie, but the number of members is unknown.
