The solar hybrid plant will supply electricity to the local population via a medium and low-voltage line. The entire solar and hybrid project is being financed to the tune of \$42.9 million by the Government of Guinea-Bissau with a loan from the West African Development Bank (BOAD). This financing was granted as early as 2017.

In early March, Sinohydro signed a contract to build a 20-MW solar farm in Gardete, some 8 km south of the city of Bissau. The signature came almost a year after the African Biofuel and Renewable Energy Company (ABREC) published the tender for the work. Set up in 2019, ABREC is a holding company made up of 14 west African states that focusses on ...
