Who is eligible for a photovoltaic tariff scheme?

This scheme is funded through national funds and applies to private individuals(natural persons) for use on their residential properties, and for organisations that are not carrying out an economic activity, provided that photovoltaic installation should have no active feed-in tariff allocation.
