

Does French Guiana have a pluriannual energy program?

Does French Guiana have a lack of energy?

The lack of access to energy in the inland areas is a key issue at the heart of French Guiana's pluriannual energy programming. With an electrification rate of dwellings four times lower than the regional average , the energy precariousness, if no further action is taken, should worsen.
