The sectoral breakdown of a country's energy demand, which is based on its economy, geography and history, can greatly impact its energy needs and which energy sources it relies on to meet those needs - such as fueling automobiles, heating or cooling homes or running factories.

The services sector tends to be much less energy intensive than industry, with the largest share of energy in most countries being used to heat and cool buildings. The shift from an economic structure based on heavy industry to one based on services has historically been a driver of falling energy intensity of advanced economies.

According to Power Technology's parent company, GlobalData, global energy storage capacity is indeed set to reach the COP29 target of 1.5TW by 2030. Rich explains that pumped storage hydroelectricity (PSH) has been central to the energy transition, having contributed more than 90% of deployed global energy storage capacity until 2020.
