

Do coin lockers allow overnight storage in Japan?

In general, most coin lockers in Japan don't allow overnight storage. Coin lockers are something to be used while you are out and about during the day. Some train stations do have a closing time, so if you think you'll be out into the evening (and even if not just in case!) look around for a posted sign that indicates hours.

How long can I store my Luggage in Tokyo?

You can store your luggage for a maximum of three days and the extra storage fee will be added after 2am every day. Are coin lockers a good idea in Japan?

Coin lockers are highly convenient if you want to explore a few hours before you head to your next destination! At coin lockers, you can store your luggage like a suitcase or a backpack. You can expect them at major train stations in Japan, and you may also find them at train stations in smaller tourist towns.

What kind of lockers do Tokyo stations use?

Most stations in central Tokyo use electronic lockers that allow you to pay with IC cards like Suica and Pasma, which is handy. Electronic lockers have English guidance, too. Smaller stations and stations in rural areas may still use classic key-style lockers. If you leave your items for longer than three days, the station staff will clear them.

You can keep the locker for a maximum of three days in most places, so keep that in mind if you want to leave your luggage for a while. If you can't find a locker or need somewhere to store your bags for a few days, you ...

How Long Can I Store My Items and Goods in a Coin Locker? Each locker can only be used for a limited time, usually up to 24 hours, without additional fees. If you're planning to use the locker for more than 24 hours, ...

It can be stored for 12, 24 or 36 h prior to processing at 4°C and it can be frozen at -80°C for 20 days and then thawed under controlled conditions. Stability of the samples can differ ...
