How should medications be stored?

1. Know the safe temperature storage range for each of your medications. 2. Store medications in the coolest area of the house. Do not place medications in an area of sunlight. 3. Medications that should be refrigerated should be kept between 36°F; and 46°F; at all times. 4.

What temperature should medications be stored at?

Many medications have recommended storage at room temperature, defined as between 68°F; and 77°F;F. These same medications also allow for temporary "excursion" periods ranging as low as 59°F;F and as high as 86°F;F. Temperatures above and beyond this range can have a significant effect on each medication.

Can medications be stored at 86 degrees?

Drugs should not be stored in areas where the temperature may exceed 86 degrees or drop below 58 degrees. Both prescription and over-the-counter medications are at risk for loss of potency and changes in chemical structure if not stored properly. Besides temperature extremes, other conditions can alter medications such as moisture, light, and time.

What temperature should medication be stored in a car?

It's not just hotter temperatures that can damage medications. The general safe room temperature for medication storage is between 59 and 77 degrees F. Medicine shouldn't be frozen, so be careful of leaving it in a car or other really cold place. For example, insulin, which is a protein, can become unstable when frozen.

How do you keep medications safe during travel?

4. Maintain consistent temperatures Keep medications within the recommended temperature range. For refrigerated items, use a dedicated refrigerator with a consistent temperature, avoiding placing medications in the door where temperatures may fluctuate. 5. Use insulated packaging for travel

Can You ship medications long distances?
