WeChat Pay is a payment feature integrated into the WeChat app, allowing users to complete payments quickly and securely on their mobile phones. Users can link their bank cards, receive and transfer money, pay bills, and make purchases both in-store and online. Download WeChat from the App Store or Google Play.

How to pay with WeChat Pay in China?

Here's are two ways you can pay with WeChat Pay in China: Scan the QR codeprovided by the merchant or by entering their WeChat ID Upon successful completion, you'll receive a notification confirming the transaction. Utilise Quick Pay and have your QR code ready for the vendor to scan

How do I pay a bill on WeChat?

To pay in stores, open WeChat, go to "Wallet," tap on "QR Code for Payment," and let the cashier scan your QR code. You can also scan the store's QR code and enter the amount you need to pay. You can pay for utilities and services directly through WeChat by navigating to the "Bills" section of the Wallet menu.

How does WeChat work?

Merchants scan the code to take the payment. Users open WeChat to scan the code, confirm the amount, and make the payment after passing the security checks. Users pay for goods or services in Mini Programs created inside WeChat. Users can pay for goods and services inside the merchant's Official Account.

Do all stores accept WeChat Pay?

Not all storesaccept WeChat Pay. Do keep an eye out for any in-store WeChat Pay signage or enquire with the staff directly before making a payment! You can also use Alipay as an alternative payment method - here's our Alipay for foreigners guide!

Does WeChat Pay support recurring payments?

Merchants can currently use WeChat Pay to support 26 settlement currencies,including US dollars, Euros, and British pounds. WeChat Pay merchants are expected to display the WeChat Pay logo for their customers to see. Although WeChat Pay supports several different payment flows, it doesn't currently process customer recurring payments.
