

Is it okay to install photovoltaic panels on dormer windows

Should I install solar panels on my dormer window?

If you are planning to purchase solar panels, you can choose to have them installed on your dormer window. They are often less visible there, allowing you to preserve the appearance of your home. Dormers with a sloping roof are perfect, but dormers with a flat roof can also be used if they are strong enough to bear the weight.

Can you put PV panels on top of a dormer window?

As you can see in the images, we had to fit the PV system around a dormer window. It's not generally possible to put panels on top of a dormer, as the roof structure isn't strong enough to support the weight (see more in our blog on domestic flat roofs). The dormers also present another challenge with shading.

How much does it cost to install solar panels on a dormer?

You can combine the solar panels on your dormer with solar panels on the roof. A household of 2 people can use 269 square feet of solar panels to fully generate the annual energy consumption. This will cost you about \$8720. The majority of the costs of installing solar panels on your dormer window are material costs.

Can you put panels on top of a dormer?

It's not generally possible to put panels on top of a dormer, as the roof structure isn't strong enough to support the weight (see more in our blog on domestic flat roofs). The dormers also present another challenge with shading. Our original plan was to have 13 panels in portrait along the top.

How to buy a new dormer?

A new dormer with solar panels: the easiest way is to buy your dormer with integrated solar panels. These are installed in the factory and are fully custom-made. This will give you the best return, because they can cover the entire roof surface and be made to measure.

Are dormer windows a problem?

Roof obstacles such as dormer windows do pose a problem, but it's possible for multiple systems to be used across a roof to suit layouts as required. Installers can be flexible to meet your needs - on various occasions panels we have installed in an unorthodox fashion to widen the square footage."
