

Does Qatar need additional gas?

“Additional gas is going to be required, whether it is from the U.S., Qatar or other places. So additional LNG and additional competition is welcome,” Saad Sherida Al Kaabi, Qatar's energy minister and CEO of state gas company QatarEnergy, told CNBC's Dan Murphy at the Doha Forum on Dec. 7.

How much oil does Qatar export?

Onshore, most oil is sent to Umm Said for refining or export. Qatar has three primary export terminals: Umm Said, Halul Island, and Ras Laffan. Qatar typically exports around 600,000 bbl/d (95,000 m³/d) of crude and about 20,000 bbl/d (3,200 m³/d) of refined petroleum products.
