

How did Typhoon Kong-rey affect Taiwan?

TAIPEI,Taiwan-- A strong Typhoon Kong-rey made landfall on Taiwan 's east coast on Thursday,the largest storm by size to hit the island in nearly 30 years,closing financial markets,causing hundreds of flights to be canceled and reducing rail services. The typhoon knocked out power to nearly half a million households,the government said.

Where did a storm hit Taiwan?

The storm hit the mountainous and sparsely populated east coast county of Taitung,according to Taiwan's Central Weather Administration,with strong winds and torrential rain affecting almost all the island. The fire department reported one person had died when their truck hit a fallen tree in central Taiwan.

How much rain will a storm bring to Taiwan?

In Taiwan,the storm had been forecast to bring as much as four feet of rain to the mountainous areas of the island. "My plans are in chaos," said Huang Shu-ting,45,as she put a bag of frozen chicken nuggets into a basket at a supermarket in Taipei on Thursday.

Will Taiwan be covered by a typhoon?

"As the typhoon continues to move towards the northwest,almost the whole of Taiwan will be covered by the storm circle later tonight," meteorologist Chu Mei-lin,with the island's weather agency,said in a press conference on Wednesday morning. The Central Weather Administration (CWA) issued a sea warning Tuesday as the storm drew closer.

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How to get to Taiwan Green Island. The journey to Green Island is a little notorious and highly dependent on the weather.
