Which region has the most solar PV installed capacity in Italy?

Lombardy was the region with the greatest share of PV installed capacity nationwide, followed by Veneto. The share of renewable electricity produced from solar PV facilities in Italy increased by almost 10 percentage points between 2018 and 2022.

The five most solar rich regions are Lombardy with 3.15 GW cumulative installed capacity (having installed 438 MW in 2022), followed by Puglia with 3.06 GW, Emilia Romagna with 2.51 GW, Veneto with 2.48 GW and Piedmont with 1.99 GW. Looking to the south of Italy, Sicily is worth a mention.
