Ivory Coast. The Ivory Coast is another major producer of mangoes in Africa, with an annual production of over 500,000 tons. Côte d'Ivoire is the second-largest producer and exporter of mangoes in Africa.

Representing 4 % of the national GDP, the mango is the number three export fruit, behind the banana and pineapple. Generating more than 10 million euros of revenue in the northern zones where it is cultivated, the mango is a flagship product of Côte d'Ivoire. Exports more than doubled in ten years, and sale prices on the markets have improved.
