

Is Luxembourg a country?

Luxembourg (/ˈlʊksəmˈbʊrg/ (i) LUK-səm-burg; Luxembourgish: Lëtzebuerg [ˈlʊtsəbuːc](i); German: Luxemburg [ˈlʊksmbʊʁk](i); French: Luxembourg [lyksəbuʁ](i)), officially the Grand Duchy of Luxembourg,[a] is a small landlocked country in Western Europe. It is bordered by Belgium to the west and north, Germany to the east, and France to the south.

Which city is dominated by Luxembourg?

The urban network in the south is dominated by the capital city, Luxembourg, which rises in tiers, with the upper (and older) section of the city separated from the lower-lying suburbs by the gorges of the Alzette and Petrusse rivers.

When did Luxembourg become the European Capital of Culture?

Luxembourg was the first city to be named European Capital of Culture twice. The first time was in 1995.

When was Luxembourg founded?

Luxembourg was founded in 963 when the Ardennes Count Siegfried built a castle ('Lucilinburhuc', literally: small castle) on the Bock cliff, around which a fortified city would grow over the centuries. Modified and reinforced countless times during centuries of foreign domination, the fortress of Luxembourg was once one of the largest in Europe.

How did Luxembourg get its name?

The purchase of this castle in 963 ce by Siegfried, count of Ardennes, marked the beginning of Luxembourg as an independent entity. The castle's old name, Lucilinburhuc ("Little Fortress"), is the origin of the name Luxembourg. Luxembourg city: Alzette River The Alzette River winding through the old quarter of Luxembourg city.
