

Does home assistant support network storage?

Even better: You can use it as a target for your backups so that when Home Assistant creates a backup for you, it will store it directly on your network storage. Multiple network storages are also supported; if you like, you can easily add more.

How do I expand my home assistant storage?

When you are running Home Assistant Operating System, you can use the following options to expand your storage: Replace your current storage medium, for example, the SD card, with a bigger one. Use a backup to restore Home Assistant from backup on the new SD card.

When you install the Frigate add-on, it should now automatically utilize this for storage due to the add-on defaulting to `"/media/frigate"` as the storage path. This worked for me. Next, install the Frigate (Full Access) Add-on.

In the UI, creating the Network Storage "share" seems successful as no errors are produced. The created share is NOT visible in "Media" & "My Media" in the UI. Using Samba Share, I navigate to the Media folder and I see the share has indeed been created, and I can navigate the files.

If the network storage was reachable when you started Home Assistant (or rather Supervisor specifically), then the mount is being setup. From that point onwards, it is on Linux to retry/reconnect in case the server goes down.
