

What is rooftop solar Yojana?

The Rooftop Solar Yojana, or the PM Surya Ghar Muft Bijli Yojana, aims to provide 300 units of free electricity every month to light up one crore households. The objective of this scheme is to reduce the electricity costs of the house by installing rooftop solar panels and using solar energy.

What is pm Surya Ghar muft Bijli Yojana?

The Government of India has approved the PM Surya Ghar: Muft Bijli Yojana on 29th February, 2024 to increase the share of solar rooftop capacity and empower residential households to generate their own electricity. The scheme has an outlay of Rs 75,021 crore and is to be implemented till FY 2026-27.

What is 'rooftop solar scheme' & 'pm Surya Ghar muft Bijli Yojana'?

The Finance Minister, Nirmala Sitharaman, announced the launch of the 'Rooftop Solar Scheme' or the 'PM Surya Ghar Muft Bijli Yojana' in the Interim Budget 2024-25. In the full Budget 2024-25, the Finance Minister reiterated that this scheme will enable 1 crore households to obtain free electricity up to 300 units every month.

What Yojana will be provided in budget 2024-25?

The Budget 2024-25 emphasised this yojana and provided that the government will provide for the installment of solar panels to 1 crore households. It will provide subsidies for installing rooftop solar panels for residential houses and using solar energy for electricity, which will help save money on electricity bills.
