Tonga could pioneer the use of wave power technology in the Pacific. (Supplied: SPTO) Power prices are affecting communities around the world and in the small island nation of Tonga -- home to just over 100,000 people -- they are feeling the pinch. "I think it's way too high.

How is energy collected in Tonga?

"There's a host of different ways to collect the energy,but the one in Tonga will be a point source absorberand it will sit in the water and move up and down as the wave passes over the top," he said. "Inside it is a generator that will spin and create electricity."

How much does electricity cost in Tonga?

According to UK-based aggregate website Cable, Tonga's electricity is the 13th most expensive in the world, at an average cost of US35 cents (52 cents) per kilowatt hour(kWh). The research, released in late 2021, analysed 230 countries and found Oceania was the most expensive region in the world, with an average of US30 cents per kWh.

How will a 'point source absorber' work in Tonga?

Ray Wills is the managing director of business advisory firm Future Smart, and chairs a number of green technology companies. " There's a host of different ways to collect the energy, but the one in Tonga will be a point source absorber and it will sit in the water and move up and down as the wave passes over the top, " he said.

Are power prices too high in Tonga?

Power prices are affecting communities around the world and in the small island nation of Tonga -- home to just over 100,000 people -- they are feeling the pinch. "I think it's way too high. Very high in comparison with current salary ranges here in Tonga at the moment," Tonga resident Mapa Taumalolo said.

This project aims to help Tonga move away from fossil fuels and shift to renewables. The project will deliver utility-scale storage systems to provide base load response and grid stability, paving the way for more renewable energy integration in the main island, while green mini-grids will be installed in the outer islands.
