

Is Russia targeting Ukraine's energy facilities?

Russia launched a missile attack on Ukraine's energy infrastructure early Friday, in an assault that President Volodymyr Zelensky described as "one of the largest strikes" on his country's power facilities.

What is Russia's energy strategy?

The energy strategy of Russia aims to maximize the use of domestic energy sources and realise the potential of the energy sector to sustain economic growth. The Strategy also aims to reduce the country's energy intensity by 56% in 2030.

How is energy used in Russia?

Total energy supply (TES) includes all the energy produced in or imported to a country, minus that which is exported or stored. It represents all the energy required to supply end users in the country.
