The department of Saint-Pierre and Miquelon is served by three television stations: Saint-Pierre-et-Miquelon 1 (call sign FQN) on Channel 8, with a repeater on Channel 31, and France 2 on Channel 6.

The islands are a well-known separate country-level entity among many radio amateurs, identifiable with ITU prefix "FP". Those visiting, mainly from the US, activate Saint-Pierre and Miquelon every year on amateur frequencies.

Saint-Pierre and Miquelon's health care system is entirely public and free. In 1994, France and Canada signed an agreement allowing the residents of the archipelago to be treated in St. John's.
