

How much will Saudi Arabia spend on energy projects in 2021?

Speaking in 2021, the Saudi government expects to spend \$293 billion on power and energy projects by then. The biggest share of this revenue is expected to be spent on transmission upgrades and renewable energy. The 300 MW Sakaka solar PV project, the first project under REPDO, set a record tariff of 1.34 USD cents/kWh in February 2018.
