President Joseph Boakai has officially broken grounds for Liberia's first-ever solar farm in Harrisburg, Montserrado County, valued at US\$90 million, marking a significant step towards enhancing the country's energy sector.

In a significant advancement toward sustainable energy solutions, the government of Liberia, through the Liberia Electricity Corporation (LEC) and World Bank Liberia, broke ground for the first utility-scale solar power plant on Friday, October 11, 2024.

Monrovia - In a bid to address the electricity shortage in Liberia, the government is currently in negotiations with Runda Solar, a multi-million dollar solar power company, to develop a 250 megawatt solar panel installation in Montserrado County.
