

Is Russia targeting Ukraine's energy facilities?

The facility has been repeatedly targeted by Russian airstrikes. Mauricio Lima for The New York Times Russia launched a missile attack on Ukraine's energy infrastructure early Friday, in an assault that President Volodymyr Zelensky described as "one of the largest strikes" on his country's power facilities.

Did Russia launch a massive attack on Ukraine's energy infrastructure?

Russia has launched a huge attack on Ukraine's energy infrastructure, which authorities said was the twelfth large-scale attack on energy facilities this year. Ninety-three missiles and more than 200 drones were used - but 81 of the missiles were shot down, according to President Volodymyr Zelensky.

How dangerous is Ukraine's energy infrastructure in 2024?

With the escalation of attacks against Ukraine's energy infrastructure in 2024, the risks are significantly higher this winter. Temperatures can routinely drop below -10 °C between December and March, posing a serious humanitarian risk if heating is not available.

Is the energy sector under a massive attack in Ukraine?

"The enemy continues its terror. Once again, the energy sector across Ukraine is under massive attack," Ukrainian energy minister German Halushchenko said on his official Facebook page. The extent of the damage had yet to be clarified, he said, while urging people to remain in shelters.

What happened to Ukraine's heating & natural gas infrastructure in 2022?

Ukraine's district heating and natural gas infrastructure has also been targeted. Since 2022, 18 large combined heat and power (CHP) plants have been damaged or completely destroyed, along with more than 800 boiler houses. Some above-ground natural gas storage infrastructure has been damaged, although underground inventories remain unaffected.

Did Russian drone attack damage Ukraine's thermal power plants?
