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A tapa showing the map of Futuna. Tapa is a popular art form which is made from the "base" of the bark of the mulberry and breadfruit trees. The pounded bark is painted with vegetable colours and with attractive designs. It provides employment to about 300 people in almost every village, and from which many families have been economically benefited in the two islands.

Wallis is a volcanic island with cones and crater lakes to explore, and Futuna and Alofi lure the occasional traveller with mountainous landscapes covered in tropical forests and untouched coastline. Citizens of most countries can travel to Wallis and Futuna visa-free " some for unlimited time and some for a period of up to 90

days.
